The sophisticated kitchen has gorgeous timber features and dark cabinets enhancing the luxe feel. You can relax by the wood fire in the open plan dining and living area and take in views of spectacular surroundings. Complementing the Japanese aesthetic, mid-century influences are evident in the design of the brick fireplaces, both inside and out, adding warmth and character. Situated in the main pavilion, the master suite is pure delight with an outlook across Port Cygnet, built-in robes and a decadent private ensuite with views from the lavish soaking tub. Connected by a covered deck, the second pavilion houses another bedroom with amazing views and an ensuite bathroom. The inclusion of sliding screens across the courtyards not only offers versatile use of the outdoor areas but also provides protection from the northerly winds. The third pavilion could be utilised as a dual living space or alternative opulent master suite as it boasts an open plan bedroom and living area, kitchenette, timber flooring, bay views, and a wood heater.
