Bring your creative flair to this inviting home, just a stroll to the tram and Dickson hub!

Situated in a great Inner North location, only a short walk to the Swinden Street light rail stop, the vibrant Dickson shopping and restaurant precinct, and Gang Gang cafe at Downer shops, this privately built and extended home will immediately capture your interest with its tastefully updated, distinctive 1960's design, which won the 1962 Women's Weekly Design of the Year Award. The home is well positioned on a corner block of approximately 773 m2 surrounded by gardens.

Timber framed windows and front deck add to the street appeal, while mature low maintenance gardens shelter the home all around, camellias and azaleas creating a splash of colour in spring.

Newly polished timber flooring is a striking feature from the entry throughout the large open plan living areas and four bedrooms. A cosy pot belly heater is a focus in the lounge and dining, adding to the ambience, and ducted reverse cycle air conditioning is newly installed.

Sunlight pours into the dining room and galley kitchen from the north aspect over cooler months. The kitchen is equipped with an upright stove and gas cooktop, a stainless steel dishwasher, pantry and downlighting.

The kitchen flows seamlessly onto a large timber entertaining deck, enjoying the sunny aspect and private view over the garden. A separate patio, protected by shade sails, provides a year round entertaining space.

The spacious master bedroom extension features windows on two sides and a door onto the front deck, all with double glazing. Adjoining is a fourth bedroom which could be used flexibly as a large nursery or study, and has a built-in robe. There are two other bedrooms, the second featuring two robes and a door to the front deck. The main bathroom includes a retro style bath, shower and a separate w/c.

The leafy gardens invite creativity, with sunlit spots to enjoy year round. There is a carport with additional parking space and two sheds, a workshop and two large water tanks.

You will love the short 180 metre stroll to the Swinden Street light rail stop for a rapid 9 minute trip to Civic. It is also a short walk to cafes, restaurants and shops in Dickson, or to Gang Gang cafe. A pre-school and park are close by and there is a wide selection of sought after schools, sporting facilities and ovals in the area. The Farmers' market is only two stops on light rail.

If so desired, the level corner block with north aspect to the rear also offers the opportunity to create a bespoke residence in this sought after area.
