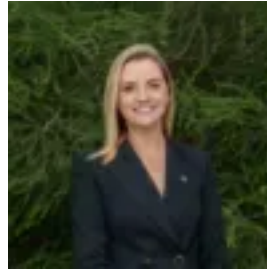

Serenely secluded this delicious offering comprises a circa 1870 four bedroom bakery and three bedroom stables conversion, linked by tranquil, established gardens. Beloved and inhabited by multiple generations of one family over forty years, once serving as studio to sculptor Joel Elenberg, it operated as Power's Bakery until 1967. Accessed from two bluestone laneways, the property benefits from secure off street parking. Triple brick, the bakery building features an innovative two storey light well with internal garden, lofty ceilings, exposed beams, exquisite Spanish doors and hand laid parquetry, harmonising with an expansive entertainer's courtyard. Presenting a living room, dining room, family room and kitchen with Italian granite topped island, the ground floor sings of happy gatherings. Superbly spacious design extends upstairs, with bedrooms presenting city glimpses and social spaces surrounding the light well. Similarly historic, the stables is drenched in north facing light with a vine draped pergola. Complete with a studio and solar panels, in an esteemed locale moments to Rathdowne Village, Capital City Trail, highly regarded schools and transport, this hidden haven is within easy reach of universities and the CBD.
