The tasteful renovation of this freestanding California bungalow allows its original soul to shine with all the classic hallmarks of its 1920s heritage creating a warm and welcoming feel. One of only a handful of homes in a leafy cul-de-sac enclave on the border of Coogee, the four-bedroom home is set amid established cottage gardens on 437sqm approx in a family friendly neighbourhood between Randwick village and the beachfront. Lovingly held and maintained for 36 years, the double-fronted classic opens to a suntrap entertainer's deck with a spacious single-storey layout that's ideally suited to family life while its peaceful location is 800m to Royal Randwick Shopping Centre with no through traffic affording a sense of peace and privacy that's rare to find. In the catchment for Coogee Public School with close proximity to Brigidine and Marcellin Colleges, this is a perfect opportunity for the young family with the express city bus stop just around the corner and 1.5km to Coogee Pavilion.
