Cosy window seating provides the perfect vantage point to soak up the sunshine while marvelling at the views. Extremely versatile, residents are spoilt for choice when it comes to living configurations and dining options, both indoors and out. The entrance level features spacious, open-plan living with combined dining, warmed by a functional open fireplace, ducted gas central heating and a reverse cycle heat pump in the dining area. Further along, a large room, currently in use as a home office, could easily become additional living space or another bedroom. The central kitchen features a Belling four-zone, fan-forced oven with gas stovetop and rangehood, Fisher & Paykel dishwasher, and an option to include the large Westinghouse fridge and freezer. There is plenty of storage, including a separate pantry adjacent. The upper-level is home to comfortable accommodation, with three bedrooms, each brimming with sunshine and each inclusive of built-in wardrobes. A smaller attic room would be an ideal kids playroom or a study. Two bathrooms service the property, one on each level. Upstairs, the newly renovated space contains an over-bath shower, vanity, and a toilet. Downstairs, there is a walk-in shower, vanity, and a toilet, with a third toilet adjacent. The over-sized laundry, and mud room, has direct outdoor access, plenty of storage, and room for everyday essentials. A wonderful feature of the home is the sheer amount of storage throughout, ideal for large, or growing families. Upstairs, numerous cupboards offer easy to reach stowage, along with under the house, accessible externally, or via the door under the staircase. The home has been designed for entertainers, with the ever-changing River Derwent backdrop setting the scene for any occasion. The sun-bathed balcony that extends from the living area showcases the uninterrupted vistas, which are equally as impressive from the terraced backyard, with a patio, and stone paved area evoking Tuscan vibes, with newly planted vines that will envelop the al fresco space over time.
