The bespoke cantilevered dining table, crafted from steel, is illuminated by hardwired lighting that sets the perfect mood.

Indulge in a luxurious 5-seat spa, nestled into a wrap-around Spotted Gum deck, while custom outdoor lighting-including unique amber tree lights and dimmable LED strips-brings the garden and brickwork to life. The land's drainage has been optimised, with oversized culverts added and the driveway newly resurfaced. A grand gabion entrance, with a remote-controlled electric gate, provides both security and style.

For the creative or the hands-on, a dedicated studio offers a workshop, storage area, and lean-to, all with its own power connection and water tank-perfect for any project or hobby.

Interior:

Step inside to find a home where every detail has been carefully considered. Recently installed double-glazed windows frame the views while keeping the interior cozy, thanks to a Saxon wood heater and a new Mitsubishi Heavy Industries heat pump. The space is bathed in ambient light from superb feature lighting with dimmers throughout. Culinary pursuits are made effortless with top-quality appliances, including an integrated Electrolux 4-burner cooktop, rangehood, and oven, along with a top-of-the-line Asko dishwasher and an LG fridge/freezer offering ice and filtered water at your fingertips. A walk-in pantry and Tas Oak hardwood flooring complete the picture of refined comfort.

The master suite is a true retreat, featuring a Tas Oak timber wall with a recessed art space, wrapped in dimmable LED strip lighting. Built-in robes, bedside drawers, a ceiling fan, and a heat transfer system ensure a perfect night's sleep, while the double-glazed window with an electric blind offers privacy and peace. Both additional bedrooms are thoughtfully designed with built-in robes, double-glazed windows, and the convenience of a heat transfer system.

Indulge in the luxury of a Blackbutt timber feature bathroom, where dimmable LED lighting wraps around custom recessed mirror storage cabinets.
