Automatic gate to the main house property with single garage and double carport in the backyard. To the rear of the property with private access off Gidley Lane offers an 80m2 commercial size shed with 3 phase power, a mezzanine floor and a bathroom. Two high clearance garage doors afford excellent access to the shed and a secure yard.
