The innovative design and authentic craftsmanship are evident in every detail, using natural, recycled, and repurposed materials to add a distinctive character throughout the home.

Bathed in natural light, the thoughtfully designed layout spans two levels. The first floor houses three bedrooms, including the master with an ensuite and private north-facing balcony. Downstairs, the open-plan living area, kitchen, dining room, and bathroom showcase the home's attention to detail. Bamboo flooring flows throughout the living area, complemented by ceiling fans and doors that open to the north, inviting the refreshing coastal breeze inside.

Everywhere you look, the bespoke interiors reveal art-like style with rustic, retro, and natural features. The master bedroom offers a serene retreat with its own balcony and retractable awning, ideal for relaxation and unwinding. Outside, the property continues to impress with multiple decks on both levels, allowing you to follow the sun throughout the day. The interior is further enriched by a stairway crafted from a single Norfolk Island Pine tree and a balustrade sourced from a single locally salvaged tree. The kitchen stands as a testament to innovative reuse, with recycled hardwood forming the cabinetry and concrete benchtops, while marine plywood covers the walls.

Located within walking distance to both Cormorant and Bawley Beaches, and bordered by a reserve and wetlands that provide convenient shortcuts to the shore, this property offers the best of coastal living.
