When it comes to the landscape, picture plentiful produce that's never seen spray in its life: organic grapes, mangoes, avocados, plums, peaches, macadamia, fig, oranges and other citruses are dotted around the property. Pastured clearings and netted vines, a marvellous retreat boasting endless options for grazing animals, harvesting food, fishing marron from the dams with the expanse to share this all with those you love most. The idyllic countryside lifestyle.

A winding winter creek courses it's way through the trees along the southern boundary, filling the spectacular lake sized dam on the journey. Create new memories with your loved ones - canoeing, swimming and marron fishing until sunset.

A second spring-fed dam downstream is suitable for irrigation if required, and there are multiple bores which supply water around the property.
