The town is made famous by the Louth Races which are held in the tiny outback town on the Darling River.Louth is a settlement on the banks of the Darling River which came into existence the moment paddle steamers reached Bourke and Brewarrina. It was established in 1859 when T.A. Mathews built a pub to cater for the passing river trade. Today Louth is known for its unusual 'Shining Headstone', a remarkable Celtic Cross on the grave of Mary Mathews (the wife of T.A.
