From the 5 inch meter inside the property, a 2 inch irrigation poly pipe with various garden taps runs along the boundary near the sheds to the middle and across the middle of the block. Several taps are located around the property from this feed. Power is also located at the front of the block and to the sheds. A Colorbond shed approximately 15m x 7 m that is council approved, concrete slab and single phase power. Also has an awning that is 4m wide by approximately 11m long and a rainwater tank. A farm shed that is approximately 12m x 18m with a concrete floor and is equipped with 3 phase power and a 20KW PV solar system. There is also the opportunity to purchase the adjoining blocks (Lot 1 & Lot 4) to allow you to purchase 60 acres.
