This well-maintained property features excellent infrastructure suited for various farming activities, making it an ideal addition to an existing portfolio or a prime entry point for mainland farmers into the Kangaroo Island farming market.

Key Features Include:

Infrastructure: Circa 1960s homestead with 4 bedrooms, open-plan living, updated kitchen, bathroom, and roof. The property is currently tenanted on a periodic lease.

Shedding:

- 1.14-stand shearing shed with annexed open-fronted shed (42m x 18m)
- 2. Older Armco open-fronted shed (18m x 6m)
- 3. Grain bunker (10m x 6m)
- 4. Open-fronted hay shed (9m x 8m)
- 5. Disused sheep milking facility and insulated storerooms (not used by the current vendor since occupation in 2009)

Fencing: All new boundary fencing and approximately 90% new internal fencing following the 2020 fires. The fencing is predominantly Cyclone 7/90/30, with a full internal raceway providing easy stock rotation and access to the shearing shed. Refer to the attached paddock plan as a guide.

Water: Numerous dams, approximately 20, are scattered throughout the property, alongside 2 winter creeks with current water flow.

Pasture Improvements: Annual and perennial sub-clover and ryegrass, with the paddock in the northwestern corner sewn to kikuyu grass. The soil is typically sandy loam over clay.

Fertilizer: Historical applications of single and DAP.

Rainfall: Similar to that of Parndana township, with a long-term average of 580mm per annum.

Stocking: Currently stocked with approximately 1,677 crossbred ewes with lambs.

Zoning: Rural.
