Fertiliser is intermittently applied, highlighting the opportunity to increase production.RAINFALL & WATERTombonda is situated in a high rainfall zone, with a long-term annual average of 979.5\* millimetres. The Property is well watered by the permanent Ournie Creek which runs parallel with the southern boundary, plus seven\* dams, including a large 15\* megalitre feature dam on the homestead. Livestock numbers have never been impacted due to water. ACCOMMODATION The Tombonda homestead is positioned in a desirable location with views overlooking the property's large feature dam with water fountain and stunning views down the Ournie Valley. The weatherboard homestead features four\* bedrooms plus study and two bathrooms. Additional features include reverse cycle air conditioning unit, slow combustion heater and new hot water system.
