The generously sized open-plan lounge and dining area opens onto the balcony with floor-to-ceiling sliding glass doors to maximise the natural light.

The kitchen is a stylish poly design with gas cooking and Caesarstone benchtops. The main bathroom is elegant with a separate shower and toilet. The internal laundry is concealed and comes with a clothes dryer. It has a split-system reverse cycle air-conditioner and a video intercom. You will enjoy the large balcony which is great for entertaining. The internal area of the unit including the balcony is 81m². There is a single secure car space with an elevated storage cage with an area of 14m², making the total area 95m².
